

## **Biennial JACT/British School at Athens Teachers' Course**

**Easter 2011 (April 10th – April 23rd, 2011)**

*Myth, Religion and Politics in the Greek City*

The 2011 JACT/BSA Teachers' Course will be directed by Dr Hugh Bowden (King's College London) and Dr. Amy Smith (Reading), in association with Professor Cathy Morgan (BSA Director). The course gives teachers first-hand experience of major sites and museums in southern Greece, in the context of lectures, reading parties and discussions designed to contribute directly to the teaching of Classical Civilisation and Ancient History at AS/A2.

The course will include site visits in Athens and Attica (Agora, Acropolis, Theatre of Dionysos, Kerameikos, National Museum; Peiraius, Sounion, Thorikos, Brauron, Marathon, Eleusis). In addition there are excursions to Delphi and the Peloponnese (including Olympia, Bassai, Tegea, Mycenae, Tiryns, Epidauros, Isthmia, Corinth).

Recently trained teachers, and those still in training, are encouraged to apply as well as experienced teachers. The course is designed to be accessible and useful to those who teach Classical Subjects as a secondary expertise, as well as to those teaching a full classical timetable; no knowledge of Greek will be expected. Those unable to attend the two week course may apply for the first Athens-based week.

The two week course fee will be £990 (£495 for the one week course) and will include all accommodation, breakfasts and lunches, entrance charges to sites and museums, travel during the course. In response to feedback the Athens accommodation has been upgraded. Single room supplements will apply and the exact amount will be confirmed nearer the time.

**Generous bursaries are available to assist teachers with the major part of course costs. Last time a total of £8,340 was awarded.**
