

FRIENDS' COMMITTEE ELECTIONS 2019

Nominations are invited for **four** vacancies on the Friends' Committee, to serve for two or four years from 1 April 2019. The current list of Supporters of the BSA in all tiers is available on the home page of the BSA website under the 'Join Us' tab. Members of the Friends' Committee must be subscribing Supporters of the BSA.

Nominations must be made on this form, which requires names of person nominated and of proposer and seconder, together with a statement of consent to the nomination and further details of the candidate. A person may propose up to two candidates, provided each belongs to a different category of Supporter (Friends tier, all tiers). An electronic copy of this form can be downloaded from the Governance page on the BSA's website, under the tab 'About Us' at www.bsa.ac.uk. Completed nomination forms should be sent to the Returning Officer by e-mail (gjs@leicester.ac.uk). **Closing date for nominations: Monday 11 March 2019.**
